EQUINE CANADA

STATEMENT OF PRINCIPAL

The Equine Canada Federation (EC) the national federation of Canada supports adherence to humane treatment of horses in all competitions under its jurisdiction. The EC is committed to:

- Upholding the welfare of horses, regardless of value, as a primary consideration in all activities.
- Requiring that horses be treated with kindness, respect and the compassion that they deserve, and that they never are subjected to mistreatment.
- Ensuring that owners, trainers, exhibitors and their agents use responsible care in the handling, treatment and transportation of their horses as well horses placed in their care for any purpose.
- Providing the continuous well being of horses by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professionals and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort, sanitation, and safety as a matter of standard operating procedure.
- Continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare.
- Increasing education in training and horsemanship practices.
- Requiring owners, trainers and exhibitors to know and to follow their sanctioning organizations rules and to work within industry regulations in all equestrian competitions.
- Reviewing, revising and developing competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of horses.

The standard by which conduct or treatment will be measured is that which a reasonable person, informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and exhibiting procedures, would determine to be cruel, abusive nor inhumane.

THE RULE BOOK

Exhibitors, Judges, and Show Officials are responsible for knowledge of the Rules. Both a complete knowledge of and compliance with the rules are essential, and all participants must be fully cognizant of all rules as well as class specifications in the division in which they compete. Full details of Horse Show operation – EC (including FEI) rules – list of recognized judges – other vital information is in the Rule Book
Copyright for exclusive use of recognized shows. See current EC Rules and Amendments. Every individual is eligible to count points won at recognized EC shows for Annual and Provincial Championship Awards. The current EC Rules and Amendments are presently in effect and have been used to compile the Rules and Regulations for this prize list. Passports are not required in a recognized BREED competition.

Regional & National Breed Shows Require a Silver Licence

Amateur Competitors: A; seniors competing in EC amateur classes must possess a current amateur card. This must be applied for at the same time as the Competitive License.

Membership to EC is now called a Competitive License. *All exhibitors, owners, trainers, riders, drivers and handlers must join EC with a competitive license to be able to compete in any EC sanctioned show.*

Temporary Sport License is available at a show for \$30.00 and does not cover accrue points

Single Event Sport License Upgrade is for a competitor arriving at a competition without the correct Sport License. The competitor pays a fee of \$15.00 to the competition to compete at a level higher than their current license. This upgrade is valid only for that competition and does not accrue points. Permanent upgrade must be done directly through the EC Office.

GENERAL RULES

1. All entries are accepted with the understanding that the Arabian Horse Association, Equine Canada, The Saskatchewan Arabian Horse Association, its officers, contract personnel or volunteers or any of its affiliates, the Prairieland Park, their officers, officials and employees will not be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury, to any exhibitor, his or her agent or employee, or to any horse or any article of any kind. The exhibitor will be responsible for any loss, damage or injury, to any person, animal or property occasioned by him, his agents or employees, or by any animal owned or exhibited by him and shall indemnify all parties above against any land loss, damages, or liability thus occasioned, including but not limited to any and all legal costs, including attorney fees, which may be incurred as a result thereof. The submitting of any entry form to the Entry Secretary shall constitute acceptance by each person signing same of the provisions herein set forth.
2. Upon any act of discourtesy or disobedience to any official or volunteer of the Saskatchewan Arabian Horse Show on the part of any owner, groom, rider, driver or handler may result in the immediate removal from the show of said person, at the discretion of the show committee and the owner will forfeit their entry fees. Such action will be reported to EC and AHA for disciplinary action. Official protest (\$100.00 cash fee) will be filed as per the EC Rule Book A1206.
3. The Show Committee reserves for itself the power to remove any person or horse from the show without being liable for compensation.
4. The Show Committee reserves the right to add to, amend, or decide any point not covered by the rules and to correct any error or make necessary alterations in the prize list program.
5. Patterns and Order of Go will be posted at least one hour prior to the class.
6. The Show Committee reserves the right to cancel any class with less than 3 horses entered.
7. See Current AHA Handbook. All AHA approved shows will use the new halter scoring system for Breeding & In-Hand Arabian & Half-Arabian Anglo-Arabian halter classes as outlined in the 2010 AHA Handbook.
8. Stallions are permitted in Junior Exhibitor Performance classes. NO Stallions are permitted in Junior Showmanship, Walk-Trot Jog and Lead Line Classes.
9. Select ATR, AAOTR, JOTR, JTR Classes are open to riders that have not won any of the following:
 - a. AHA Regional Top Five or better in the corresponding class or any open class in the respective division.
 - b. AHA National Top Ten or better in the corresponding class or any open class in the respective division.
 - c. TWO AHA Regional Top Five Awards or higher in a corresponding Select class.
 - d. An AHA National Top Ten or higher award in a corresponding Select class.EC Article B1502.6
Riders of Arabian – Half- Arabian Anglo Arabian horses competing in the same section shall not be considered separately. If a rider is eligible to compete as a Select rider in a respective section on Dec 1, said eligibility remains throughout the competition year.
10. Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the current rules of EC and will be held and judged in accordance with the EC Rule Book. (EC Article A602.2)(EC Article A602.1)
11. Competition Numbers must be worn and visible at all times in the schooling and exercise rings.
12. The Show Steward shall have full power to act for, and on behalf of the Show Committee during the entire show.
13. The number of horses calculated as competing is at the closing of the gate and the beginning of the class for all classes shown as a group and all those who pass through the gate in individual activity.
14. Awards:
 - Regular Classes: Ribbons to 3rd place
 - Medal Classes: Ribbons to 5th place. Medal to first place if more than 3 exhibitors.
15. The Arabian Scoring System and the In-Ring procedure will be used for In-Hand Classes.
16. Barn Calls are a courtesy only. Exhibitors are responsible for being ready to show when their class begins.

AHA EQUITATION MEDAL CLASSES***SPECIFICATIONS***

AHA HUNTER SEAT NOT TO JUMP MEDAL

1. Open to Juniors who have not yet reached their 18th birthday, prior to December 1st.
2. Following the rail work, two or more individual tests from EC Article B3602 & G111 shall be required.
3. To receive a medal in this class, three competitors with proper appointments must compete.
4. Exhibitors in this division MUST wear protective headgear with a safety harness permanently affixed to the helmet. Safety vests may be worn without penalty.

AHA SADDLE SEAT EQUITATION MEDAL

1. Open to Juniors who have not yet reached their 18th birthday, prior to December 1st.
2. Following the rail work, two or more individual tests from EC B3604 with requirements 1-15, Article F410.
3. To receive a medal in this class, three competitors with proper appointments must compete.
4. Exhibitors in this division are encouraged to wear protective headgear with a safety harness permanently affixed to the helmet which may be worn without penalty. Safety vests may be worn without penalty.

AHA REINING SEAT EQUITATION MEDAL

1. Open to Juniors who have not yet reached their 18th birthday, prior to December 1st.
2. Exhibitors must execute a pattern from the Rules of Equine Canada, Section K Reining. No rail work is required. Article B3606.
3. Dropping of bits is optional with the judge, but if called for in the ring, assistance, if necessary, may be had from any one of the ring officials.
4. Reins shall not be removed from the horse's neck while inspecting bits.
5. In an AHA Reining Seat Medal Class an off pater rider is eliminated and note eligible to win a medal or ribbon.
6. To receive a medal in this class, three competitors with proper appointments must compete.
7. Exhibitors in this division are encouraged to wear protective headgear with a safety harness permanently affixed to the helmet which may be worn without penalty. Safety vests may be worn without penalty.

AHA WESTERN HORSEMANSHIP MEDAL

1. Open to Juniors who have not yet reached their 18th birthday, prior to December 1st.
2. Following the rail work, two or more individual tests from EC B3701.3 with requirements 1-11.
3. Exhibitors in this division are encouraged to wear protective headgear with a safety harness permanently affixed to the helmet which may be worn without penalty. Safety vests may be worn without penalty.

AHA HUNT SEAT OVER OBSTACLES MEDAL

1. Open to Juniors who have not yet reached their 18th birthday, prior to December 1st.
2. Following the rail work, two or more individual tests from EC B-3602 & G1110.3a-p.
3. Exhibitors in this division are encouraged to wear protective headgear with a safety harness permanently affixed to the helmet which may be worn without penalty. Safety vests may be worn without penalty.

Medal Winners may ride in any Medal class throughout the year. (AHA Article 1119.5b)

Once an equitation class or section at any show has begun, no individual shall ride or school a horse entered in that class unless that individual is the person entered on and showing said horse. Any Violation shall result in disqualification of horse and rider from that class. (Refer to current AHA rulebook)

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR

Article A905.4 states Junior competitors must wear proper fitting, approved protective headgear, with the safety harness correctly secured, at all times while mounted on competition or event grounds.

Approved Headgear meets the ASTM (American Society for Testing Materials) standards and displays SEI (safety Equipment Institute) Seal. The British standard, BSI, is also acceptable.

Directly from EC Article B1306.7 – If the Junior is competing in a discipline or breed whose rules specify other headgear (e.g. western hats, derbies etc); those rules supersede the new rule. However, all breeds and disciplines do allow protective headgear, with no penalty and we urge members to put safety ahead of tradition and adopt the new rule. Therefore, no helmets are mandatory as yet in Saddle Seat or Western Classes, but they are recommended.

MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

1. GENERAL

An AHA Competition Level Membership in AHA (Chapter 7 in Current AHA Handbook) and EC-USEF is required for all riders, drivers, owners, lessees, agents or trainers and handlers. (See EC Article B1302.2 page 42 EC Rule Book). Exceptions: Owners that are listed on the registration papers as and or and/or, for show purposes, only one owner is required to be a member. An EC Temporary Sport License may be purchased for the show. (Article B1302.2.iii) Single Event Memberships in AHA may be purchased for \$35.00 per exhibitor per show.

2. AMATEUR

All exhibitors showing in AAOTR and AAOTH classes or exhibitors over the age of 18 years as of December 1st, showing in AOTR and AOTH classes **must** have a current Amateur card from EC USEF. The Amateur Status must be applied for separately from an individual sport license and is not automatic. Eligible amateurs can complete a Temporary Sport Licence form, sign the Temporary Amateur Affidavit portion, and submit the fee and exhibit at that competition as an amateur. EC Article B1303.7.d.

3. FARM , SYNDICATE OR BUSINESS

Horses registered in the ownership of a Farm, Syndicate or Business **must** have an AHA and EC USEF Farm Membership (see Article B1304.2) or Certificate (see Article A210 p. 4 in Rule Book). AHA Business Membership must be purchased directly from AHA.

DRUG TESTING

All horses are subject to a drug test fee for each show. By entering the show all owners agree to a drug test for their horse(s) if selected for one. A charge of \$3.50 per horse will be made and is included on the entry form. EC Article A602.5

*EC Statement: Any horse entered in any class at a competition subject to the requirement to pay drug testing fees may, while on the competition grounds and on the recommendation of the chairman of the provincial Equine Medication Control Committee or the chairman`s appointee, be selected for equine medication control testing.

RULES REGARDING PROTESTS

A protest at an EC recognized competition, other than those specific matters covered in the division rules, must comply with the following:

1. A protest is eligible only if made by the officiating Judge, an owner, lessee, trainer, and competitor or authorized agent in the Division in which the question arises. A protest must be made in writing and addressed to the Show Secretary of the competition at which the matter under consideration occurs, must be signed and must be accompanied by a deposit of \$100.00 in cash. EC Article 1206 A copy must be sent to the EC National Office and applicable Provincial Office.
2. A protest must contain a specific statement and rule number of an alleged violation of a rule or of a condition of a class and must give the full name, and if possible, the address of the alleged violator. The maker of the protest must be prepared to substantiate the protest or charge by personal testimony, sworn statements, witnesses or other relevant evidence.
3. A protest must be filed within forty eight hours (48) of the competition of the class concerned.
4. For further information regarding protests and appeals, refer to EC current Rule Books.
